



**Regulation No. 42/2020
of Rector of the University of Opole
of May 19, 2020,
as amended on July 17, 2020**

**on tuition fees and other charges collected by the University of Opole in the
academic year 2020/2021**

Pursuant to **Article 23(2)(10)**, in connection with **Article 79** of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2020, Item 85, as amended), **Section 13(4)(7)** of the Statute of the University of Opole (Resolution No. 293/2016-2020 of the Senate of the University of Opole of 18 June 2020) and **Section 6(1)**, in conjunction with **Section 1** of the Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 21 May 2020 on the incorporation of the State Medical School of Higher Vocational Education into the University of Opole (Journal of Laws of 2020, Item 938), I order the following:

§ 1

1. This regulation specifies:
 - 1) fees charged by the University of Opole to students and foreigners pursuant to the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science,
 - 2) forms and deadlines for payment of fees referred to in section 1(1).
2. Terms used herein shall be understood to mean:
 - 1) student - a person enrolled on a degree programme at the University of Opole in the academic year 2020/2021 who is a Polish citizen or a foreign national referred to in Article 324, section 2 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science,
 - 2) foreigner - a person commencing and pursuing studies at the University of Opole, in the academic year 2020/2021, referred to in Article 323(1) of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science.

§ 2

This Regulation shall apply to students and foreigners commencing their studies in the academic year 2020/2021.

§ 3

1. Tuition fees and other charges collected by the University of Opole are specified in the appendices to this Regulation:
 - 1) tuition fees on the part-time programmes are specified in Appendix 1 to this Regulation;
 - 2) tuition fees on the part-time programmes for foreigners are specified in Appendix 2 to this Regulation;

- 3) fees for repeating classes because of unsatisfactory academic performance, the fees for classes not covered by the programme of study, and other fees charged by the University of Opole are specified in Appendix 3 to this Regulation.

§ 4

1. Forms and deadlines of payment of fees referred to in section 3 are as follows:
 - 1) for students: fees for part-time studies shall be paid in eight [8] equal monthly instalments, payable in advance from October to January and from March to June by the tenth [10th] day of each month,
 - 2) for foreigners:
 - a) fees for a semester of full-time and part-time studies shall be paid before the start of the semester, not later than the day of the start of classes in accordance with the programme of studies,
 - b) fees for postgraduate studies, scientific and artistic internships, habilitation internships, trainings, and for participation in scientific research and development work shall be paid no later than the date of their commencement.
 - 3) for students and foreigners: fees for repeated classes listed in Appendix 3 on full-time and part-time programmes shall be paid before the beginning of each semester:
 - a) winter semester - by September 30,
 - b) summer semester - by February 28
2. The date of payment of the fees referred to in subsection 1 shall be the date of crediting the bank account of the University of Opole.
3. In the case of payment of the fees referred to in subsection 1 after the date specified herein, the University of Opole shall be entitled to charge statutory interest for late payment.
4. The University of Opole shall not be liable for any consequences of the bank's erroneous classification of the fee paid, resulting from circumstances attributable to the student or foreigner obliged to pay the fee, in particular as a result of indicating an incorrect bank account number.

§ 5

The regulation shall enter into force on the date of signature with effect of 15 July 2020.

**Tuition fees for foreigners commencing their studies in the academic year
2020/2021**

From the academic year 2020/2021, the tuition fees for studies and other forms of education for foreigners taking up studies at the University of Opole on a tuition fee-paying basis are as follows:

- 1) for full-time first-cycle, second-cycle or long-cycle programmes - annually PLN 5,000.00 (PLN 2,500.00 for each semester), subject to point 2;
- 2) for full-time first-cycle, second-cycle or long-cycle programmes at the Faculty of Health Sciences - annually PLN 6 800.00 (PLN 3 400.00 for each semester);
- 3) for postgraduate diploma studies, research and artistic internships, habilitation internships, trainings, and participation in scientific research and development work in accordance with the calculation of costs of education;
- 4) for part-time first-cycle, second-cycle or long-cycle programmes - in the amount of fees that apply to students (Appendix 1 to this Regulation).

Fees for repeating classes due to unsatisfactory academic performance, fees for classes not covered by the programme of study, and other charges collected by the University of Opole in the academic year 2020/2021

I. Fees for repetition of certain classes on full-time studies due to unsatisfactory academic performance

1)	Fee for repeating courses due to unsatisfactory academic performance within the repetition of a semester or a conditional credit	70 PLN/ECTS point
2)	Fee for repeating courses due to unsatisfactory academic performance within the repetition of a semester or a conditional credit on the medical programme	500 PLN/ECTS point
3)	Fee for repeating courses due to unsatisfactory academic performance within the repetition of a semester or a conditional credit on dietetics, physiotherapy, cosmetology, nursing and midwifery	110 PLN/ECTS point
4)	Fee for practical classes taken at the additional date on dietetics, physiotherapy, cosmetology, nursing and midwifery	220 PLN/ECTS point
5)	Fee for repeating PE classes	100 PLN/semester
6)	Fee for educational services related to repetition of classes by foreigners	rates specified in points 1, 2 and 3

II. Fees for classes not covered by the programme of study

1)	Fee for the continuation of foreign language learning beyond the limit set in the plan of study	250 PLN/semester
2)	Fees for the participation in recreational and sports activities for students over the limit specified in the plan of studies	60 PLN/semester

- b) *the candidate has erroneously paid a higher amount of money;*
 c) *invalid registration – no registration for a given programme, or payment after due date.*

The fee shall be reimbursed upon a written request from the candidate submitted by October 30, 2020 (summer admissions), or by March 31, 2021 (winter admissions). The instruction and the application template are available on the Online Registration System (IRK) in Fees tab. The application confirmed by the Rector's Proxy for Admissions is directed to the Bursary and the refund is made to the account given by the candidate.
