In addition, it depicts the local ‘VIP’, the dinosauriform *Silesaurus opolensis* that was unearthed from Upper Triassic strata.

## Abstract guidelines

The abstract should clearly describe the importance of your study to the field of palaeontology and contain purpose, results, and conclusions. It should all be written in English, font ARIAL, letter size 12, and contain no more than *250 words*. **Do not** include references or figures/graphs in the text.

**The title should be written in Arial Black, size 12 – it is limited to 150 characters, including spaces.**

The author(s) name and affiliations should be written in Arial Narrow, size 11.

Please save the abstract under the *corresponding author's last name* (e.g., Smith.docx)\*. Acceptable file types are: docx, doc and odt. While sending the final version of the abstract to [paleontologia@uni.opole.pl](mailto:paleontologia@uni.opole.pl) please indicate whether you prefer a poster or an oral presentation and which session your work matches the best (i.e., vertebrate palaeontology, invertebrate palaeontology, micropalaeontology & palynology, palaeobotany, new techniques in palaeontology, popularization or other).

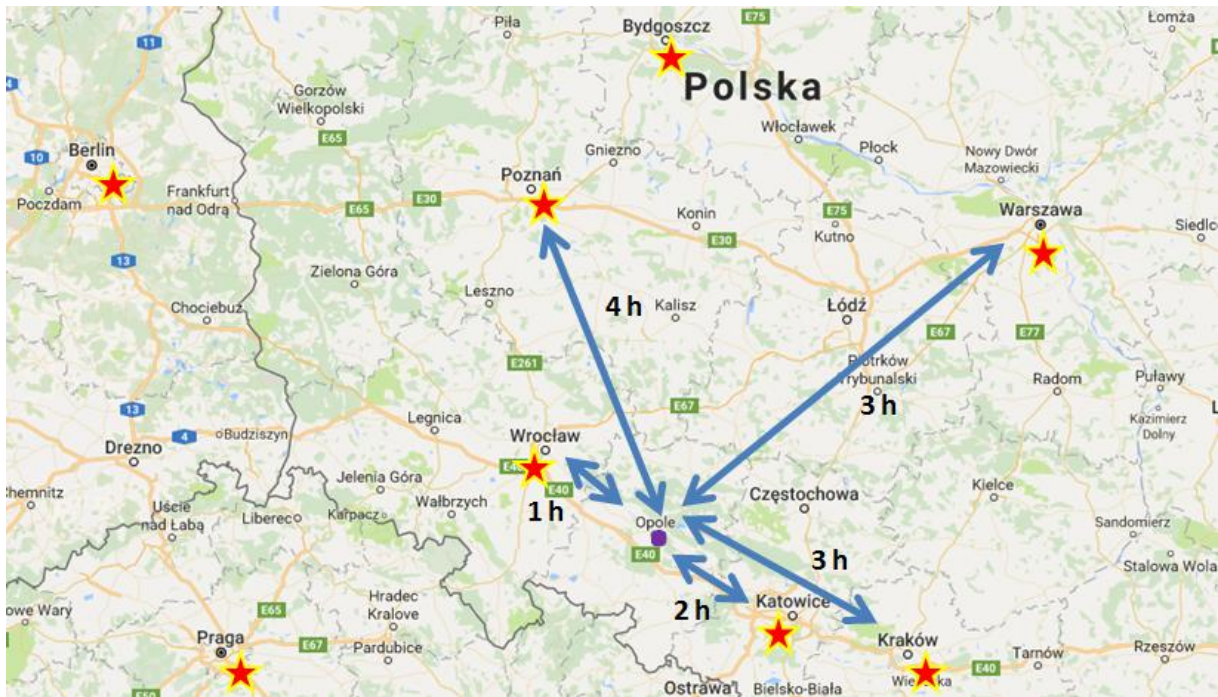
All abstracts will be peer-reviewed and since the nature of the submitted research topics will be diverse, you are kindly asked to name **three possible reviewers** for your work, in order to help with the assignment of suitable reviewers. The name of possible reviewers should also be included in the email that contains the abstract.

## Field trip proposal

On the last day (May 21, 2018) we are planning a field trip to Mesozoic outcrops in Opole Voivodeship. However, it will depend on the final number of participants who wish to attend. You will also have the opportunity to be involved in excavations at the Krasiejów site (Upper Triassic) and at the Odra Nowa quarry (Upper Cretaceous). To help us organise all this, please inform us if you wish to take part. More information on the localities to be visited will be made available in the Second Circular.

## Arrival

More detailed arrival tips to Krasiejów will follow with the next circular. However, we have composed a map that indicates the nearest airports (yellow-red star). The blue arrows stand for possible train connections to Opole, noting maximum travel time (NOTE: these are direct connections). Moreover, there is a direct bus departing from Berlin Main Bus Station and Berlin-Schönefeld Airport which takes around 6 hours to reach Opole.



## Venue

The ice-breaker party will take place in the building of the *Old School* at Krasiejów, that nowadays holds a library and an exhibition of faunal assemblages from the fossil sites of the region with a special focus on the Late Triassic Krasiejów fauna. In addition, poster presentations will be staged in this historic building.



The oral presentations will be held in the Theatre Room of the *Park of Science and Evolution (PNiEC)* at Krasiejów.



The Farewell dinner will be organised at the JuraPark. In addition, there will be free entrance and a guided tour to the scientific exhibition as well as to the commercial part of the Park. Depending on weather conditions, you will also have the unique opportunity to visit the active excavation site of Late Triassic vertebrates and invertebrates.
