Abundance of international students

High quality studies at a more favourable price in comparison to other European countries.

In spite of the fact that Poland is undergoing rapid economic growth, the cost of living remains significantly low, e.g. about 400–500 euros will be more than enough to cover accommodation, food and transport costs.

Polish universities are integral part of the European Higher Education Area, taking active part in the Bologna process.

Having graduated from a university in Poland, foreigners receive a high quality European degree, recognizable all around the world.

Since 2015, full-time foreign students are entitled to work without labour permits.

Opportunity to acquire greater language proficiency

English language proficiency is the most important requirement to get enrolled. In case foreign students have not mastered English at a desirable level, they have two options:

participate in the 3-week Summer School (400 Euros) during which students combine vacations with intensive language classes and afterclass activities. Besides English, they acquire basic Polish and get familiar with European culture and society in general, and with the local way of life, in particular

take up 1-year English language preparatory course (1600 Euros), which is meant to prepare foreigners for their further studies in terms of language and other skills, such as analytical and critical thinking, problem solving, team work, project based learning, etc.

Exchange programmes at the University of Opole

MOST: STUDY AT ANOTHER
UNIVERSITY IN POLAND

The idea behind the project is to let the students in Poland get to know other universities. As a full-time student of the University of Opole you can apply for an exchange semester in a different Polish higher education institution. Your grades and credits would be recognized as if you studied in Opole.

ERASMUS+ STUDIES: STUDY AT OUR PARTNERS'
AROUND EUROPE

As a student in any international programme lectured in English one will be encouraged to apply for Erasmus+ grant. This program lets you study at any of our partner universities in Europe for a semester or two. Studying outside Poland can be a bit more expensive, so you will be granted approx. 300–500 EUR per month to make your living at our partner university, be it in the Czech Republic, Germany or Spain. Sometimes we also have openings for studies outside the European Union. Your mobility period will be recognized by the University of Opole. Erasmus+ is a great opportunity to study in English and to get to know even more cultures and people.

There is also an opportunity to have an internship at virtually any company or organization based in the European Union. Erasmus+ programme enables you to find any hosting institution where you can get the professional training.

We will support you with a grant – approx.

400–600 EUR per month do spend you summer or even a year after graduation working professionally.



The World of Erasmus Exchange

THE IDEA

The Erasmus programme is a project of the European Commission. It aims for an exchange of experiences between countries, universities, their students and staff. The goals of the programme are to assist in cooperation between higher education institutions in different countries, to increase the students competence, and develop their language and intercultural communication skills.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Students of any nationality studying at a higher education institution in European Union can apply for an Erasmus study exchange or internship mobility and along with it be granted a monthly scholarship ranging between 300 and 700 euros. Travel costs are reimbursed as well.

RECOGNITION OF OUTCOMES

In the European Union the student mobilities' outcomes are easily recognized at both the partner universities owing to the system of granting ECTS points for each course or exam passed. Institutions with other assessment systems agree on appropriate evaluation method before the mobility.

WHO CAN APPLY

All the European Union members, as well as Liechtenstein, Norway, Iceland, Turkey and Macedonia are able to take part in the programme. Grants for mobilities with partner universities in other countries are also possible.

KEY ACTION 107

One of the Erasmus+ projects grants scholarships for student and staff mobilities outside of European Union. BA and MA students from Poland cannot apply for exchanges with some of the countries. For the staff, however, as well as the incoming students, there are currently no limits.



For Students' Progress and Comfort

RICH PRINT AND ONLINE LIBRARY RESOURCES

Apart from the building where the main library of the university is located, each faculty has its own library with places to study, computers and xerographic copiers.

The libraries offer not only printed books, but also access to multiple digital databases of books and papers.

WELL-EQUIPPED LABORATORIES AND ACCESS TO RESEARCH SOFTWARE

The University of Opole provides for its students all the necessary facilities for studying, practice and conducting their own research: computers, up to date data analysis software, and scientific research equipment.

STUDENT'S CULTURE

Student Cultural Centre is a modern building where presentations, workshops and cultural events are organized. The halls can be rented free of charge by the students who want to take initiative and organize their own performances and meetings.

SAFE AND COMFORTABLE ACCOMMODATION

At the university campus located in the centre of Opole, there are four dormitories, five of the eight faculties and a student health centre. The dormitories have affordable (about 70 euros) single, double and triple rooms and guest rooms each equipped with a fridge, tables, shelves and closets for the students. Bathrooms with showers are shared between 2–4 rooms, depending on the building. The students and staff living in the dormitories can use a shared kitchen and a laundry room (at least one of each for every floor).

FACILITIES FOR SPORTS AND RECREATION

The Centre for Physical Education offers indoor gyms with modern equipment and a number of sport halls. The students are obliged to attend a physical education class of their choice. Apart from traditional sports such as volleyball, basketball, football or swimming, students can choose hiking, biking, horse riding, mountaineering, ice skating, yoga

or zumba – to name a few. Outdoor professional sports fields complex located at the campus is available for the students as well, and in the spring and summer an outdoor gym situated just next to one of the dormitories is widely attended.

by the sending institution (based on the credits and educational outcomes). The next round of applications for Erasmus+ Key Action 107 starts in November 2017.







BA, MA and PhD study programmes

The University of Opole will be pleased to offer high quality education in the form of full study programmes in all three levels of academic education. Especially MA and PhD programmes may be dedicated for the universities interested in investing in their human resources and sending us their prospective employees. The tuition fee for non-EU citizens starts at 1100 EUR per academic year.

Full time students of our study programmes are invited to participate in exchange programmes within the European Union and are eligible to spend a semester or an academic year at yet another partner university in Europe within the framework of Erasmus+ programme with full financial support of living costs in another EU country. We can also organize summer professional training in companies across Europe with the same funds.







Summer Schools

The University of Opole can organize a summer school for your students or academic staff on a special topic: English language, English for academic purposes, Research methods in social sciences, Project based learning and new teaching methods etc. We are ready to host a group of 30 or 60 or 100 participants for a cost rounding at 400 EUR (no travel costs to PL included) in the period of June – September.
