MA in English Philology, Intercultural Communication, or Master of Liberal Arts

The graduate of English in Public Communication can apply for MA studies at any European university. The University of Opole offers 2 year MA programmes in Intercultural Communication (Sociology), English Philology, and Master of Liberal Arts.

MASTER OF LIBERAL ARTS MA PROGRAMME

Master of Liberal Arts is, for the University of Opole, a brand new approach to the field of study that has always been defined from the top down and divided arbitrarily. The University of Opole has prepared a programme, holistic and interdisciplinary in its nature, which combines humanities and art with elements of social and judicial sciences.

Master of Liberal Arts programme is the response to the limited specialisations of STEM type of studies where neither human and social factors nor critical approach to technology are taken into consideration. Our programme differs from the traditional form of Master of Liberal Studies mainly due to the specialisations that are adjusted to demands of the labour market, namely, Creative Industries, Digital Media, Applied Gender Studies, Public Communication, etc.



INTERESTING SUBJECT OF STUDIES

During the course of studies, we will be raising key issues of modern society, such as social inequalities, migration, propaganda and creation of discourse, identity and algorithms in digital media, intercultural business relations, and others. Division of the programme into specialisations allows students to gain not only conceptual and theoretical foundations of modern phenomena, but also creates favourable conditions to acquire essential practical skills which will be highly valued by prospective employers.

VISUAL COMMUNICATION MA PROGRAMME IN ART EDUCATION

In the era of communication, connectedness, visuals and information overload, the world needs not only skilled creators but also aware educators and inquisitive analysts. The master's programme in Visual Communication consists of three paths blended in one field. They are grounded in the domains of art, education, and communication with a strong emphasis on visual arts.

Nowadays, with abounding images and narratives, there is a constant need for sound inquiry into the visual cultures as well as good artistry in the field. The development of creative skills in graphic design, printmaking, drawing, and illustration is one of the main objectives of the programme.

The artistic craftsmanship, especially in digital environments, is supplemented by the emphasis on understanding and interpretation of contemporary art and artworks. This enables our students to become informed, conscious, and critical art educators. Last but not least, the skills to analyze communication processes (semiotics, semantics, rhetorics) are developed as well as the means to see the broader context of society and culture. We shape creators, educators, and communicators to work either in the art institutions or culture industries or in marketing and advertising spheres.

Comprehensive art training

Our graduates will acquire a blend of creative skills in visual arts, including designing in the industry standard Creative Suits, and substantial theoretical background to understand the visual cultures.

Soft skills

*to get enrolled in Visual Communication MA programme you will have to pass an exam consisting of two parts: review of the portfolio (10 works of art minimum) and interview on the topics of contemporary art, art history, and communications. The exam can be passed online.

EUROPA MASTER MA PROGRAMME IN POLITICAL SCIENCE

Europa Master called “Weimar program” is a unique triple programme created and administered jointly by the University of Opole, the University of Mainz, and the University of Burgundy. The purpose of the programme is to prepare specialists in the area of European integration and make students aware of different “faces” of the united Europe.

An international group of students recruited on even basis by each of the partner universities study together during the first semester in Opole, during the second semester in Mainz, and during the third semester in Dijon. For the fourth semester students choose the university where they want to prepare their Master’s thesis. In each semester students are obliged to study two foreign languages, with French, German, and Polish being three basic languages of choice.

EUROPE MASTER programme is FREE of charge to all the students irrespective of their country of origin.

Multiple Opportunities

The programme gives a unique possibility to study at three different universities in three different countries in an international group of students and to receive three diplomas.

ERASMUS PROGRAMME

Students of any nationality studying at a higher education institution in the European Union can apply for an Erasmus mobility and be granted a monthly scholarship ranging between 300 and 700 EUR. Travel costs are reimbursed as well.
