Documents confirming language proficiency (consistent with Annex 2 to the Ordinance of the Prime Minister of 16 December 2009 on the methods of civil service admission procedure (Journal of Laws No 218, item 1695)):

## 1. BA or MA diploma in philology:

- 1) graduation from philology study programme in the field of foreign languages or applied linguistics;

- 2) graduation from teacher's college of foreign languages

2. **Doctoral studies or professorate in English:** document issued abroad confirming the obtaining of a degree or a scientific title - the language of instruction of the institution providing education is recognized.
3. **BA or MA diploma in English:** Document confirming the completion of higher studies or post-graduate studies conducted abroad or in the Republic of Poland - only English as the language of instruction is recognized.
4. **High school diploma:** A document issued abroad equivalent to a secondary school-leaving certificate - English as the language of instruction is recognized.
5. **International Baccalaureate Diploma**
6. **European Baccalaureate**
7. **English proficiency certificates:** Certificates confirming English proficiency at least on B2 level in on the scale of the global fluency according to „Common European Framework of Reference for Languages: learning, teaching, assessment (CEFR)“:
  - a. certificates issued by affiliated institutions in Association of Language Testers in Europe (ALTE), namely:
    - i. First Certificate in English (**FCE**), Certificate in Advanced English (**CAE**), Certificate of Proficiency in English (**CPE**), Business English Certificate (**BEC**) Vantage — at least Pass, Business English Certificate (**BEC**) Higher, Certificate in English for International Business and Trade (**CEIBT**),
  - b. Certificates issued by the following institutions:
    - i. Educational Testing Service (ETS), namely:
      - Test of English as a Foreign Language (**TOEFL**) — at least 87 points in the Internet-Based Test (iBT);
      - Test of English as a Foreign Language (**TOEFL**) — at least 180 points in the Computer-Based Test (CBT) together with at least 50 points from the Test of Spoken English (**TSE**);
      - Test of English as a Foreign Language (**TOEFL**) — at least 510 points in Paper-Based Test (PBT) together with 3,5 points from the Test of Written English (TWE) and 50 points from the Test of Spoken English (TSE);
      - Test of English for International Communication (**TOEIC**) — at least 700 points.

        - a. English for Speakers of Other Languages (**ESOL**)
