PROJECT FORMAT

- Psychology students from three different universities work together in multi-national groups, using virtual communication platforms, to analyse and compare different theoretical or practical aspects of psychology
 - Three different countries and cultures represented in each group
 - Virtual engagement, coordinated by academic staff in each university
 - Outcome: group poster or online group presentation

OBJECTIVES

- Enable peer-to-peer global learning and intercultural engagement for students without having to travel
- Improve understanding on how same discipline and concepts are approached in different cultural contexts and legislative frameworks
 - Enhance students' communicative abilities and professional English
