

## **RULES OF GRADE CONVERSION FOR “OLD MATURA”, INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB), EUROPEAN BACCALAUREATE (EB) AND BACCALAUREATES GAINED ABROAD INTO “NEW MATURA” POINTS**

### **1. Genral remarks:**

- 1) If the certificate makes no distinction between the higher level (HL) and standard level (SL), the points resulting from the conversion will be treated as points gained on a higher level.
- 2) „Old matura” – means matura exam passed before the year 2005.
- 3) „New matura” – means matura exam passed after the year 2005.
- 4) The grades taken into consideration during recruitment from a maturity exam certificate (“old matura”) or secondary school leaving certificate and from a higher education diploma are converted into “new matura” points in accordance with the table below:
