As you may know, Poland is divided into sixteen districts named voivodeships – in view of the fact that the conference will be held in the Opole region, we have decided to create a logo to reflect this, as in previous years. The logo illustrates the contours of Opole Voivodeship, filled in with the local colours, yellow and blue. In addition, it depicts the local 'VIP', the dinosauriform *Silesaurus opolensis* that was unearthed from Upper Triassic strata.

We will offer a more detailed plan of the field trip separately, but here comes the short draft:

Starting with the Late Triassic active excavation site in Krasiejów where you can mostly find disarticulated parts of large temnospondyls, through the invertebrate fauna at *Strzelce Opolskie*, where you will be able to collect well-preserved brachiopods. Next, at the interesting not only for its geological but also to its historical importance – at *Mt. Saint Anna* where we will climb a little in a natural park. To end at a Cretaceous active quarry in the Opole city, a marvellous quarry in which you cannot find only invertebrate fauna in the form of Poland's biggest ammonites, but also mosasaurid and plesiosaurid teeth!
